**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER # 2007-00-08**

**RE: APPROVED SUPERVISED VISITATION PROGRAMS WITHIN THE  
FOURTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT**

**Whereas**, Supreme Court Administrative Order dated November 18, 1999, and signed by Chief Justice Major B. Harding, directs each chief judge to enter into an agreement with supervised visitation centers that are willing to comply with the Supreme Court of Florida's minimum standards for supervised visitation programs;

**Whereas**, Rule 2.215 (b) (2), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, establishes that the chief judge of a circuit "shall exercise administrative supervision over all courts within the judicial circuit;"

**Whereas**, Rule 2.215 (b) (3), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, directs the chief judge to develop an administrative plan for the efficient and proper administration of all courts within the circuit;

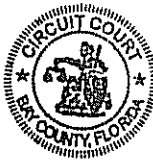
**Now Therefore**, it is **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** that pursuant to the aforementioned authorities vested in the Chief Judge of the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit that those supervised visitation programs who have a signed visitation agreement with this circuit will comply with the attached standards issued by the Supreme Court of Florida.

Also, the judges within the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit shall ensure that only those supervised visitation programs that have a signed agreement will be used when ordering parties to a supervised visitation program, and shall order parties to use such programs, if appropriate.

Lastly, the family law court staff for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit shall maintain a list of all supervised visitation programs that have a signed agreement with the circuit and periodically update the judges of the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of the programs that remain current providers. The family law court staff shall maintain a list of supervised visitation programs on the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit's website.
